## Chapter 1 - The End of the Beginning, the Beginning of the End

### INT. CASTLE - CLASSROOM. DAY

MISTER FRANKLIN stands at the head of the overly large classroom, surrounded by ancient tomes, scrolls and other scholarly items. His sole pupil, LILLY, is staring into the distance and paying no heed.

MISTER FRANKLIN  
...whereas Elves are a lofty, untrustworthy race;  
lightfingers and skyjackers all...

There is a large crashing sound in the distance.

LILLY  
What was that?

MISTER FRANKLIN  
Hmmm... One second child.

Mister Franklin walks over to the window.

[The player is free to move Lilly and investigate the room: if she investigates the bookshelves she'll find a 'Scroll on Vargs'; once Lilly stands next to Franklin, the following dialogue occurs]

In the distance, smoke can be seen rising from a part of the castle.

LILLY  
What's going on?

MISTER FRANKLIN  
I'm not sure child...

LILLY  
Let's go see!

MISTER FRANKLIN  
I'm not sure that's such a good idea...

[The player is free to move Lilly around; as she moves to the door Mister Franklin speaks]

MISTER FRANKLIN  
Wait for me child!

[Franklin joins the party]

**INT.CASTLE - CORRIDOR.DAY**

The corridor stretches into the distance on both sides. Sleeping next to the door is the Bearman, ROWAK.

[If the player clicks on the bearman, the following plays]

ROWAK

zzzzz.... huh?

MISTER FRANKLIN

Wake up, Rowak.

The Bearman slowly stands up and stretches.

ROWAK

Wha'?

MISTER FRANKLIN

Something's going on and the little one is refusing to listen to me; she wants to investigate.

ROWAK

\*Sigh\* 'spose you be wanting me to come with and do my duties, then...

MISTER FRANKLIN

Precisely!

ROWAK

Let's go, then. \*Sigh\*

[Rowak joins the party]

**INT.CASTLE - BALCONY.DAY**

After getting to the battlements, the courtyard can be seen. The castle drawbridge has been blown up, leaving smoke and fire everywhere. Large stone golems stomp into the courtyard destroying all in their path. The KING MERRIK and his personal guard exit the main castle and prepare to engage the enemy.

LILLY

Father!

VARG TROOP

Up there! On the balcony!

A swarm of stoney warbirds fly towards the party. Rowak draws his weapon.

KING Merrik

Lilly! No!

ROWAK

Get behind me!

[The party engages in combat with the stoney warbirds]

LILLY  
What's happening?

ROWAK  
We're under attack!

MISTER FRANKLIN  
We must get the princess out of here.

LILLY  
No! I've got to get to my father!

Below, the King and his personal guard are losing the fight. He looks up to Franklin and nods. Franklin nods back.

MISTER FRANKLIN  
You know what to do, Rowak.

The Bearman picks her up and turns to run.

LILLY  
No! Put me down!

They move through the castle [fighting Varg troops as they go] until they get to a secret exit and leave.

#### **EXT. CASTLE. DAY**

Outside the castle the Varg forces are even more numerous.

[The party engages in some stealth action to avoid being caught]

Before entering the nearby forest a white flag of surrender is rasied above the castle walls.

#### **EXT. FOREST - CAMP. NIGHT**

The party sit around a makeshift campsite. Lilly is in a huff.

MISTER FRANKLIN  
I am sorry that we took you as we did, but it was what your father wanted.

ROWAK  
Right thing to do too.

MISTER FRANKLIN  
Ceratinly was. Are you ok Lilly?

LILLY

I wanna see my dad...

MISTER FRANKLIN

I understand little one, but we can't do that right now.

LILLY

Then what do we do?

ROWAK

Well... With the King captured, you're the ruler now... What do you think we should do?

LILLY

Em... I'm not sure. I don't want my family captured. I don't want those guys in my home.

MISTER FRANKLIN

So what, dear child, do you intend to do about it?

LILLY

This is just like what happened in Tipolee, fifty years ago.

MISTER FRANKLIN

So you do pay attention in class, after all.

ROWAK

She might, but I don't. What're you talking about?

LILLY

The Tipoleens were invaded by the Hoorde...

MISTER FRANKLIN

... a force far superior in numbers.

LILLY

So the Tipoleens fought back gorilla-style.

MISTER FRANKLIN

Not gorilla, Guerilla. Small numbers, fast attacks.

ROWAK
